

*Today, you are beholding an in-depth review on Fatima, and related international topics, a supplement to **Alert: For The Times, Book of Secrets**. However, this compendium of historical keypoints is not for the light of heart or weak. Beware. The story of Fatima traces its roots to the WW I era. Lucia became a nun of the Sisters of St. Dorothy after leaving Fatima. Technically upon becoming a nun, Lucia was officially Sister Maria das Dores up to March 24, 1948. Throughout this compendium it is Lucia.*

keypoint 1 May 13, 1917: Our Lady of Fatima appears for the first time high on the slope of the Cova da Iria to 3 children: Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco, appearing as a lady in white on a small oak tree, of the holm genus. She said, “I am of Heaven.” From the right hand hung a Rosary with white beads ending in a cross of silver. Her dress fell down to the feet which were on a little ermine cloud which came over the green branches of the shrub. A white veil, with edges adorned with a line of more intense light that looked almost like fine gold, covered the head, shoulders, and fell almost as low as the dress. She “radiated a light more clear and intense than crystal glass filled with water” with the rays of the Sun shining through it. This light had different tones, yellow, white, and other nuances. Her hands had a “flesh-colored light.” She said in a soft and pleasant voice, “Do not fear. I will do you no harm.” She pronounces more visitations.

keypoint 2 The Lady appeared on June 13 to the 3 children revealing the future, “I have been sent by God with a message for every man, woman and child living in this century.” Two rays of light encompassed the children who perceived a heart on the Lady, circled and pierced by thorns. She specifically told them, “Jesus wishes to make use of you, to make me known and loved. He wants to establish in the world devotion to My Immaculate Heart.”

keypoint 3 The whole sky became darker, and the temperature went down and everybody saw the sky become yellow as gold on July 13. The children were revealed secrets, one of which was the permitting of a vision of Hell—known as the First Secret of Fatima. A young engineer named Mario Godinho offered them a lift in his new automobile when they finally left. He took a snapshot of the children (right, below) when they made a brief stop near the church in Fatima, in which the kids looked horrible. That was because on July 13, everybody saw and heard the children scream. As Our Blessed Mother spoke to Lucia Her last words-in the words of Lucia- She “opened Her hands once more, as she had done during the two previous months. The rays of light seemed to penetrate the earth, and we saw as it were a sea of fire. Plunged in this fire were demons and souls in human form”. Lucia could hear the words of Our Blessed Mother. When the vision of hell was given, all three kids saw and heard the vision of hell. A solemn warning was given that July 13, followed by a promise of historic prophecy, announced three months in advance. The place. Day. And, hour. But, lastly Lucia received the Third part of the Secret: There was “an Angel with a flaming sword in his left hand. Flashing, it gave out flames that looked as though they would set the world on fire, but they died out in contact with the splendor that Our Lady radiated towards him from her right hand: pointing to the Earth with his right hand, the Angel cried out in a loud voice: Penance, Penance, Penance!



“And we saw in an immense light that is God: something similar to how people appear in a mirror when they pass in front of it, a bishop dressed in white. We had the impression that it was the Holy Father. Other bishops, priests, men and women religious going up a


steep mountain, at the top of which there was a big Cross of rough-hewn trunks as of a cork-tree with the bark; before reaching there the Holy Father passed through a big city half in ruins. And half trembling with halting step, afflicted with pain and sorrow, he prayed for the souls of the corpses he met on his way; having reached the top of the mountain, on his knees at the foot of the big Cross he was killed[...]" Excerpt From: Robert C. Valentine. "Alert: For the Times, Book of Secrets." This third part of the Secret was not revealed until June 26, 2000.



keypoint 4 On a rainy day, October 13, 1917, the great miracle of Our Lady of Fatima. "The Blessed Mother outstretched her hand just as she was leaving, opened her hand and rays of light extended in the direction of the sun. The sun broke through the clouds, and gradually grew pale so all could gaze."



The sun brightened as light seemed to blend and gleam from The Blessed Lady's hands, to paraphrase Lucia's own words. It swayed and danced. It appeared as a silver saucer. Rays of multi-colored light

streamed from the Sun in every direction, every color of the rainbow; lasting several minutes. The Blessed Lady specifically tells the children to pray the Holy Rosary. There were over 70,000 witnesses.

keypoint 5 August 19, 1927: A new method for a church to co-exist with the socio-political world was unveiled, by Metropolitan Sergius, known as the Adaptation for the Russian Orthodox Church, which called for the Orthodox Church to only stick to things spiritual and any deviation was considered a non-religious activity and is to be stopped. ie. cannot condemn the government.


keypoint 6 The Blessed Lady appeared to Lucia at Tuy, Spain, on June 13, 1929, to ask for the consecration of Russia w/ all bishops to Her Immaculate Heart; it is not publicized.

keypoint 7 On May 13, 1931, in a sacred ceremony, Portuguese bishops consecrate the nation of Portugal to the Immaculate Heart of Mary; two years earlier they had offered a consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Great Depression globally hits hard.

keypoint 8 Lucia receives a message from God the Son, Jesus, Who tells her an analogy to King Louis XIV when Heaven's commands were done late, the Church's ministers will "follow the example of the King of France in delaying the execution" in other words for not following the command. (Louis XIV was told certain requests in 1689.) He tells her, "They have not chosen to heed my request." "They will follow him into misfortune." It is understood that this is a future warning regarding modern requests to the Pope and his bishops, given in Rianjo, Spain, 1931, while Lucia was staying with a friend, but it is not publicized.

keypoint 9 Sept. 12, 1935: The bodies of Francisco and Jacinta exhumed; Jacinta's body (actual photo, r) was found to be uncorrupted in spite of being buried in quicklime since 1919.

keypoint 10 Portugal escapes the total horrors of the Spanish Civil War and World War II. Over 6,000 priests were captured and tortured in the Spanish Civil War. About 280 nuns were also captured, some were raped, some had their eyes gouged



out, others were dragged by chains from fast cars until they died.

keypoint 11 March 19, 1937: In his Encyclical on Atheistic Communism by Pope Pius XI: ...the Catholic Church could not and does not remain silent. This Apostolic See above all is not refrained from raising its voice for it knows that its proper and special mission is to defend truth, justice and all those eternal values which Communism ignores or attacks.

keypoint 12 A great, strange light appears Jan. 25, 1938 over Europe, as foretold.

keypoint 13 Tri-Axis-signed Treaty for world domination, a rainbow coalition signed by Germany, Italy, Japan on Sept. 27, 1940 under a pro-military advancement, with tri-themes of 1. New World Order. 2. Racial Supremacy. 3. Anti-religious code.

keypoint 14 After an order by the Bishop of Gurza on Oct. 24, 1940 to write the pope and request for the consecration of the world a most unusual visitation, kept secret from the world, whereby Lucia had a special visitation by Jesus Christ Who told her it was His wish a consecration of the world to the Immaculate Heart of Mary be performed.

keypoint 15 June 22, 1941: The USSR was invaded by Nazi Germany, 2 totalitarian socialist states at each other's throats, one a national socialist, the other an international socialist, and both despise freedom of religion, one wishes abolishing it forever. In less than 6 months, the United States enters WW II, officially.

keypoint 16 Negotiating the past, a book "Meravigle di Fatima" is published by Rev. Gonzaga de Fonseca May 13, 1942, in which is revealed for the first time to the public the first 2 secrets given by the Blessed Virgin; it is claimed to avoid offending nations, worldly affairs supersedes certain heavenly words said in 1917: the word "Russia" is replaced by "godless propaganda" and the consecration of the world was substituted for consecration of Russia.

keypoint 17 Pope Pius XII does a consecration twice, once on radio by himself, mentioning the "world" by name but, not Russia, Oct. 31 and Dec. 8, 1942. The partial consecrations were done to the Immaculate Heart of Mary but not in the way She originally requested. On Oct. 31, 1942, he created the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary on the Saturday after the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

keypoint 18 In a secret letter to her spiritual director (dated Feb. 28, 1943) Archbishop Don Manuel Ferreira, Lucia told him the content of the 1940 consecration as executed in 1942, was held in approval by God, and that Lucia was told He promises the world war would be shortened. However, she also stated the "conversion of Russia is not for now." WW II ravages on, the evil forces are free to sound the 2nd Trumpet of Revelation.

keypoint 19 January 3, 1944: Our Lady again appears to Sister Lucia and bids her to write down the third part of the secret. She writes down the Third Secret in the middle of WW II; later reveals the Blessed Mother wishes it to be revealed in 1960.

keypoint 20 June 17, 1944, Sister Lucia will not allow anyone but a bishop to carry the one-page letter containing the words of our Lady in the Third Secret. Up to this date it has not been given to the bishop of Fatima. On this date, a bishop visits an orphanage where Sister Lucia

stays, entrusts the secret to him, and he later gives it to Bishop Jose da Silva on the same date.

keypoint 21 Using the basic power of the universe, A-Bomb explosion, Aug. 6, 1945: God's hand of protection is extended to eight Jesuit priests in Hiroshima less than 8 blocks from A-bomb epicenter who are spared all radiation and death; survivor Rev. Schiffer attributes it to the daily Fatima prayers and Holy Rosary recited together.



keypoint 22 The Second World War ends in 1945, about 15 million battle deaths; a minimum of 45 million civilian deaths; numbers vary. The US and USSR are the most powerful countries on the face of the Earth.

keypoint 23 May 13, 1946: Lucia returns to Fatima as Pope Pius XII crowns image of Our Lady and proclaims her “Queen of the World.”

keypoint 24 July 15, 1946: Historian William T. Walsh interviews Sister Lucia. In answer to a question from the professor, Lucia points out the Blessed Mother did not ask for the consecration of the world but only and specifically Russia; it is pointed out in his book *Our Lady of Fatima*, which sold over a million copies.

keypoint 25 Franciscan and former artist Petrus Pavlicek believed in the assistance of the Blessed Mother so much creates the Holy Rosary Crusade of Reparation in soviet-occupied Austria in 1947. He believed that prayer could save his country. Rev. Harold V. Colgan establishes Marian movement The Blue Army, to increase worldwide devotion to Our Blessed Lady and Her Immaculate Heart.

keypoint 26 State of Israel proclaimed May 14, 1948. Karol Wojtla earns a doctorate in Sacred Theology from Jagellonian University. First Junction transistor invented at Bell.

keypoint 27 Sister Lucia was interviewed by a Dominican from N.Y. Rev. Thomas McGlynn in 1949. When he read that “Our Lady has asked for the consecration of the world...” Lucia stopped him. In his book *Vision of Fatima*, he recalls that Lucia was emphatic in making the correction about Russia. “No!” she said, “Not the world! Russia! Russia!”

keypoint 28 April 13, 1950: All priests and monks in Czechoslovakia arrested by secret police and imprisoned in special labor camps “for priests”; all their property confiscated by the State—most notorious was Jachymov, a “camp” near a uranium mine where many priests died from radiation.

keypoint 29 Sept. 11, 1950: Rev. Petrus Pavlicek and the Austrian chancellor lead a procession of prayer of some 15,000 people in Vienna, in protest of the occupying Soviet forces.
