INTRODUCTION

This book principally follows the theme of changing climate and all the concepts and events associated with it, from both the perspective of those who derive the future through the signal strengths of the mind and from the scientists who want to quantify everything. If a larger solar disturbance occurs, then it is a different story; and one can be sure that a change in many people will occur over the horizon and instinctive human fears will play out.

From the sinister apocalyptic message of two men who lived over 400 years ago, Nostradamus and St. Malachy, I base we are in, or entering the end, of the popes of the Catholic Church as we know it. It is complicated. It involves loss of spiritual wisdom for both the Vatican and society as a whole, and it is detailed in my book. To understand the difficulty of our relationship to the Christian faith, is to also understand the relationship of climate, weather, an astonishing set of circumstances and an appearance of a mysterious convergence. What this convergence is, is a matter of debate.

People and psychics, they tell us, have spoken of the Antichrist and Satan during prescribed final days. Residents of the Southwest and Midwest, whose cultures resonate a oneness with nature, mention the loss of spiritual wisdom. In an ancient Hopi legend, that reverts to a Native American example, the Purifier is the brother who shall return during the end time and shall fight those coming from the west in war. During this time, children will turn against their own parents as the material sense of knowledge erases spiritual wisdom. They refer, however, to the present as the final age of preparation when mankind forgets to walk the path with the Creator. People fall into a natural fear when the unknown appears to sketch conclusions. For example, the occurrence when the scenario of impending doom, associated with a new millennium, marked itself. As the clock ticked closer and closer to Jan. 1, 2000, imprinted on our minds were the warnings speaking of doom and forbearance. Anybody and anything was quoted, from Nostradamus to the Aztecs; from the change of an age to the complexity of the galaxy. However, none of that compares to what is happening now.

Lucia, the last of the three visionaries who saw and spoke with the Blessed Mother, died on Sunday, February 13, at 5:25 pm, 2005. She passed away in her cloistered convent at 97, about a month short of her 98th birthday. The night before, she received a fax from Pope John Paul II and was so taken by the specialness, she seemed to have recovered her strength and “her little eyes were illuminated” so declared her nephew Salesian priest Jose dos Santos Valinho, who was there.

The funeral was celebrated in the Cathedral of Coimbra Feb. 15. The Portuguese Government declared Tuesday, Feb. 15 a day of national mourning. Sister Lucia dos Santos had very poor eyesight--she was not blind as some news agencies posted--in the months preceding her death.

That her death occurred on the 13th may have some significance in that the thirteenth was always the day in which the historic apparitions of Mary took place. Born Lucia de Jesus to Antonio and Maria Rosa on March 30, 1907, Sister Lucia had been a Carmelite nun since 1949.


Sister Lucia spoke of Fatima in her 4 published memoirs, but never was allowed to reveal the “3rd” Secret publicly in her lifetime. The Vatican issued a Fatima module June of 2000 that not only made an attempt to explain the 3rd Secret, but cited a university scholar Rev Dhanis who did not believe in the three children of Fatima and what they stood for. It was the only Fatima source the Vatican cited in the module of 2000 for religious reference.

The Third Secret of Fatima was first penned by Sister Lucia in 1944. Vatican sources love to state Sister Lucia had only met Pope John Paul II only 3 times (in '82, '91, '00) but, as seen in this report, there existed another time (or times) she had met with the Pontiff privately. Moreover, Pope Benedict XVI said on May 13, 2009, “You promised the 3 children of Fatima ...‘in the end, My Immaculate Heart will triumph.’ May it be so!”

Francisco and Jacinta Marto, the two cousins of Lucia, were beautified on May 13, 2000, and Sister Lucia undertook a rare journey outside of her convent to witness, alongside over 70,000 people, the special ceremony. There exists more to historically review than is possible in this introductory, however, may I suggest this book that reveals the story of Fatima and Lucia, which means light or the light of dawn. The spiritual world mourns the loss of a special light in a world covered by growing darkness.




This blue diagram shows the number of auroras from 1550-1750. Atmospheric circulation has always been affected to the degree of solar activity. Auroras nearly disappeared during the Maunder minimum. From tree rings and ice cores, we know our Earth recently completed a very nice warm period, the height of the Medieval Warm Period, the opposite of Maunder Minimum, when solar activity was also high, but not quite as high as Cycle 23. That period was circa AD 1000. Our current solar cycle is number 24, and it started in Spring 2010. Super Cyclone TC05B hit India and Pakistan October 1999; worst areas were in Orissa, India where over 9,700 people and some 190,000 livestock perished. U.S. mid-section fell to either catastrophic floods or fires at the same time in 2011. Texas fires consumed over 40% of all fires in America at one time in 2011.

I. A HISTORICAL INSIGHT TO THE TIME

People are falling again into a novo, natural fear with the scenario of impending doom associated with the year 2012. And as that clock ticks closer and closer to December 2012, a new set of imprints on our minds—warnings speaking of doom and forbearance—brings new sketches of doom. Here we go again.

To be sure, change will always exist. I wrote about this when I was first writing my first volume of the Second World War, and it will always be with us. I have written a book with visions of disasters and apocalyptic themes. Our world was opened up to the state of fear and of things mystifying and terrifying with Art Bell and his program *Coast To Coast AM*; some fears were generated by men such as Major Ed Dames, and others, like Gary North. Some topics dealt with supernatural manifestations or ghosts. The peculiar thing about all this, is that increased knowledge is followed by greater fear, if you let fear take hold of you. Our generation and those that will follow will possess a greater knowledge than we ever will believe. By listening to George Noory or Art Bell in their current transcription, the fear factor has not evaporated. Fear cannot be totally erasable. The attack on the World Trade Center and Washington D.C. leaves one to reflect on one's future. In the ensuing years since 9-11, it behooves us to acknowledge that numerous changes have occurred. Military and self-defense have taken higher priority, just like it did in the monumental Second World War. However, warnings from the scientific community augment the spectrum. So, you see, this book's research is not just about the so-called end-times, a new version of the apocalypse, nor about a little connection here and a little connection there, all sounding like fiction. I see a world primarily hit by an imbalance of a Catholic Church wilting away and not caring about what the Blessed Mother offers.

I write about an astonishing set of circumstances, not easily understood. I include the enlightening stories of four people, besides the better known Fatima and Garabandal: Andrew Wingate, Gordon-Michael Scallion, David Booth and Maj. Ed Dames. Their stories rise above the rest. Could an iridescent link exist? Variations of ill omens, astonishing circumstances, and peculiar phenomena exist, amidst

everybody's current world of society which is more and more unbalanced. A future can come in the immediate or distant. However, I believe, to try to walk in a better future, one needs to know the past. To understand the relationship of our future is to understand a forest of knowledge of our past that is connected to the story of Fatima. My strength is not as futurist. I am an historian, and perhaps, my book *Alert: For the Times, Book of Secrets* will provide a better understanding of history not found in any book. The information is not found in any religious book, either.

It took me a long time to put everything together.

You will receive information no other book provides.

One of the most important lessons in this is the 3rd Secret—a floating concept for many—is composed of 2 parts. The importance of Booth to Sister Lucia is here. Nobody was supposed to know that. Way back in 2004, Booth had a heart attack and his heart stopped for 6 minutes. But, he was revived at the University of Tennessee Hospital. Booth's sister, a real nun, was murdered after Booth went public with the message entrusted to him by Lucia. After, I go public with all of this information internationally, perhaps things will become a little more interesting for me, too.

Our daily life is packed with stress and challenging things. We all have things to do, homes to care for and worlds of our own to tend. On one side of the coin, people want to better their life, and their family's and loved ones' and community's. It has been that way ever since the first settlers.

Today's science carries over into the world new heights and new-found power, bringing the human spirit into contact with a wealth of delight, a mountain of knowledge, unto a height of novelties in this ever-changing struggle.

When I began formulating this book on January 8, 1996, about 149 weeks remained in the astronomical chart before the Spring of 2000. On the other side of the coin, things that you cannot see or touch or feel, (or watch on TV) commands little or no attention. However, behind the scenes they interact with you. Lasers, the electron bonding of molecules or even a meteorite crash in El Paso, Texas on October 9, 1997, or Hurricane Katrina. Some you interacted more directly with, while others were an impediment of life. In all our "yesterdays and todays" people have always stumbled in the hallways of time, yet pulled themselves out of hard times. I am sorry to say this, but, unlike the past, we live in strange times, and it is perhaps time to hear what some people say, yet, not let fear get the best of us. The levels of survivability require forbearance, although bear in mind the focus will profanely not permeate everyone on every continent evenly, according to the consensus of everyone in my book. Fear

factor #1. The specific quadrant of time, from 1997-2011, is thorough; further chronicled in “Recent geophysical disturbances and displays, 1997-1999” of the book, as you will read.

Maelmhaedhoc O’Morgair, known as St. Malachy Latinized to Malachy, purportedly wrote a certain list about the papacy, naming popes from AD 1143 until “the end of the world.” Fear factor #2. He is but one of two men who lived four hundred years ago that I will include in this special book. One reason for this is: what is said about the papacy needs to be addressed. In one form or another, the papacy has been in the news.

The end times are synonymous with patterns of judgment and resurrection. Going back to the psychic spectrum, I specifically cite what our futurists once predicted. When it was spoken, it was more a prophetic thing of the future. But, once it crossed the threshold of prophetic motion, it passed into the world of history. Fear factor #3. Many of the things they see are alarming. The things they have made us aware of are documented in precise detail regarding our changing climate.

I do not concentrate on one person. Fear factor #4.

Each subject was researched independently. Noone knew I was doing my book, not even Art Bell.

In the fact of survival, sometimes it is wise to pay attention to the signs. Just like the Mandan, Shoshone, Nez Perce and Hidatsa tribes helped the Lewis and Clark expedition survive, we can look to help offered by certain people today. They have sighted things we know little of. I believe one method of survival is to listen to those who describe future conditions, much of which I believe is relevant to the Sun. Survival will be acrimonious rather than harmonious.

Only by reading the book will you see the sad similarities they see about the future. They are unpleasant. Most of them in the beginning used to hint there was a great chance it could be averted. As time elapsed, that idea faded fast. Fear factor #5. This book is written as an augmentative series of data points linked to the story of Fatima, and in no way is meant to replace it.

I am happy to report some of the most intimidating things have not come true...
ONLY BECAUSE THEY BELONG TO THE FUTURE.

Charlton Heston said in a January 1997 speech, “As the Century closes, great men seem an endangered species. Great Men move the world, not only by what they do in it, but what they tell us about it.”

One such man with the ability to see the future is a mystic in the Catholic Church, Reverend Andrew Wingate.

Father Wingate is leader of the Marian Movement of Bishops, and Oblates of St. Therese of the Holy Child Jesus, which he formed in 1987. He is a visionary and has had visions since childhood. During his youth he was dyslexic. One of 17 brothers and sisters, his first locution occurred at age 7 when he did not really understand. He was only 7 and had made his First Holy Communion when Our Lord told him he was going to be a priest and he was told he was to form a sacred society called the Oblates of St. Therese. In the ensuing years, he was visited by St. Michael the Archangel, as well as other saints, such as St. Therese, St. Clement, St. Theodore, and the Mother of God, Mary. He married. Then, by special dispensation, he became a Catholic priest.

The Oblates order is more like a society. The community grew. However, many cardinals do not like him, or his order, but Pope John Paul II knew of him; incidentally, on September 23, 2004, he told George Noory on the radio program *Coast To Coast AM* the prediction that right after Christmas, John Paul II will have another sudden drop of health due to people trying to kill him. Remember what happened to the Pope at the end of January 2005? Father Wingate is a strange priest and rarely wears his Roman collar outside unless on special church business.

Since the mid 1980s, he has felt an inner need to focus on various messages on the end times, a messenger of the End Times if you will. I was skeptical of Wingate when I first heard of him on January 3, 2003 on *Coast To Coast AM*. His appearance on *Coast To Coast AM* was part of a plan. But, it must be noted. Wingate never contacts the studio. The studio contacts him. And, a national audience then heard of him. They learned of him and many things about his visions and messages, one of which he was to give to the world: the end times are here. He has travelled the world studying and examining numerous mystics who have published information concerning the future.

Is Rev. Wingate a part of “the signs” which humanity is supposed to receive before the time of great changes? Some of the things you will read sound dramatic, to say the least. Yet, to paraphrase Malachi Martin, who gave his impression on astrology, God can manifest His will and tell you what to do through various material hap-

penings, provided “you saw it all through the hands of God.” The nature of Rev. Wingate is a study of both the material and the realm to which the middle plateau belongs—one of three plateaus of reality, of which are the physical reality, the Supernatural reality, and the middle plateau which harbors the psychic perceptions. Like remote-viewing, the messages he receives enter the paranormal, the range between the Supernatural and the physical.

Wingate, in certain respects like Nostradamus and St. Malachy, pronounces the state of the papacy as future historical events, as you shall read. A message is intended to forewarn, hence he falls in the same state: Andrew Wingate, Gordon-Michael Scallion, and Maj. Dames. The end-result can be measured quantitatively as a material happening, exactly as the range of warnings as covered by my subjects in depth in *Alert: For The Times, Book of Secrets*. Stage 1: the various warnings are given. Stage 2: we have the ability to watch and monitor the occurrences. Stage 3: the warning either comes true or is false, as measured by steady observance. Stage 4: the historian records it, and the transgression or accurate phenomena is noted.

However, the main difference between Wingate and my other subjects is that he is not just a voice that belongs to the middle plateau. The appointments in time, as is understood through him, are instructions from Heaven. That distinctly places him alongside theological revelations, namely Fatima and Garabandal. But, Fatima has been church-approved by the Catholic Church; Wingate has not been. Garabandal is not church-approved or sanctioned worthy-of-belief either, but Malachi Martin, who believes in the warnings and messages of Garabandal, went so far as to candidly state to Art Bell on radio on July 14, 1998, Garabandal is a repetition of the Third Secret in brief.

Rev. Martin did not need Vatican approval to make that statement, nor any man-made body of tribunals, for that matter. Martin recognized that Jesus Christ through the Mother of God, had chosen times and places to warn humanity, other than Fatima. Perhaps, you the reader, would be prudent to keep that thought in mind.

Fatima occurred over 90 years ago and is based on mystical visions. Gordon-Michael Scallion (GMS), Sean Morton, Ed Dames, were brought up Christian, so was Wingate. The warnings of GMS are based on mystical visions. Maj. Dames is not based on mystical views, but Andrew Wingate is. As we trace the road of the entire spectrum through time, we will not have a comprehensive understanding until anything resembling a life-altering consequence passes. We can choose to totally ignore it.

However, how does one account for the points in time that have come true as foretold? You will see what I mean in a little while. Perhaps it is prudent to at least investigate and act upon an alternative. The evidence is not meant to peer into the

horizon; it is written to tabulate history, with an emphasis on the weather and climate change.

Although segments of my writings appear to be fiction, nothing is presented as a fiction book. There are numerous things that sound utterly fantastic, and at no point am I asking you to believe everything. My research is not the first to present a handful of authors and futurists who tell us calamity awaits humanity around the next bend; however, my best advice is to see if there is an emerging pattern and if there are enough events of a prophetic nature that happen as they were foretold. Concerning all my subjects, I try to include a brief biography for each one. In keeping with this tone, I include a biography of Father Wingate—some of which has never before been put in print. Who is Wingate? Let us go back in time to the late nineteen fifties.

The Blessed Mother first appeared to him when Wingate was still 7.

The mystical experience began when he had just finished going to confession in a church, and saw a statue of the Sacred Heart. That's when he started to see the vision of a mountain. It was in color. So he began climbing up. The Blessed Mother appeared to him in a white dress trimmed in gold. She wore a crest of the Oblates around her neck. The Blessed Mother was on top of the mountain. No angels were with her. She told him "Don't look behind you. Just hold on." The Blessed Mother reached down to take his hand. She said, "Listen to us. To myself and my Son. We will lead you step by step. Remember, I will always be here." She was helping him be lifted up. Her right hand was filled with some liquid. As Wingate puts her hand down, the little boy notices lots of other people behind him also trying to come up. At this time a rain in his hand seems to shoot up and it rained and "poured out on them." The Blessed Mother was still atop the mountain. Jesus was standing almost behind Her, but to Her side. She was sitting on a marble-like seat. Little Wingate was never scared.

He told me in one of our conversations that he felt he just had to be with Her on top of the hill or mountain. After the initial talk with the Lady, She said to him, "Here is what I am offering." His Guardian Angel was by now in the vision.

She told him, "Listen to me very carefully." After the Blessed Mother spoke and explained to him, the Guardian Angel spoke, "Listen carefully. This is your future."

Little Wingate was standing in the presence of Jesus, who was standing. Jesus was wearing a yellow cream tunic that was trimmed with a thin edging of gold. Wingate felt as if he was in the presence of someone he was very familiar with. Again Wingate told me he felt no fear, only that he wanted to be there. Jesus asked, "Do you want to help my mother?" Wingate nodded yes. He told Wingate, "You will become one of my shepherds of the Church. You will found a new sacred society like none other. And, it will be for the salvation of my Church, and a great multitude of souls. For all.

And, many priests of all kinds, who will be consecrated to my mother. With Her, (referring to St. Therese) the two of you will do this for Her glory (referring to his mother Mary). This is the will of my Father, if you desire to do this.” Wingate nodded again in approval.

He said, “In return, I offer you one of these crowns.” Wingate was shown 4




crowns. One was covered with all kinds of precious stones. Another appeared to be all pearls. Another had a golden crown with rubies. The last was a crown that looked like an iron grill. Wingate pointing to the iron one asked, “Can they be like this one? Can some of the stones be on this one?” Jesus replied, “I will base it all upon this one.” Little Wingate asked, “Do you think she will like this one?” He replied, “Yes, if it is given to Her from you.”

Wingate said, “Yes, I would like to, someday.”

Both the promoter and the translator almost leaped off the floor saying, “No. No, he is not having any visions.” Calmly, Fr Wingate said, “Yes, she is here. Please tell that to Father Gobbi.” So they sat down, numb. He told the translator to repeat what he had just said. After the translation, Fr Gobbi looked up and then began talking very rapidly, and he got faster and faster. Fr Wingate showed Fr Gobbi a small medallion.

In an instant Gobbi’s eyes leaped out of his head in disbelief, telling Wingate that this was the sign that had been promised from Heaven to him. Whoever would show him the medal was the person who was to be his successor. He told Wingate, “You are the successor I have been looking for.” Fr Wingate was taken by surprise. But, that is only half the picture. He told Wingate he will continue his work.
